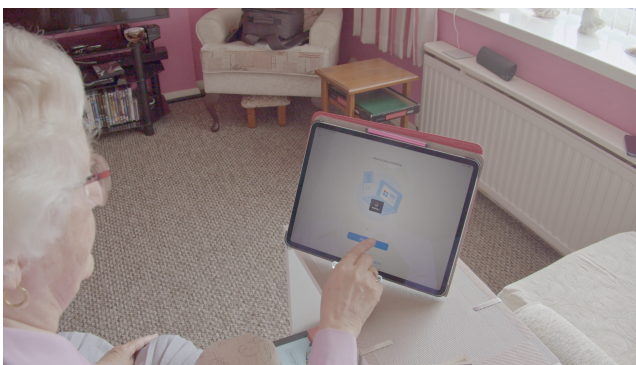
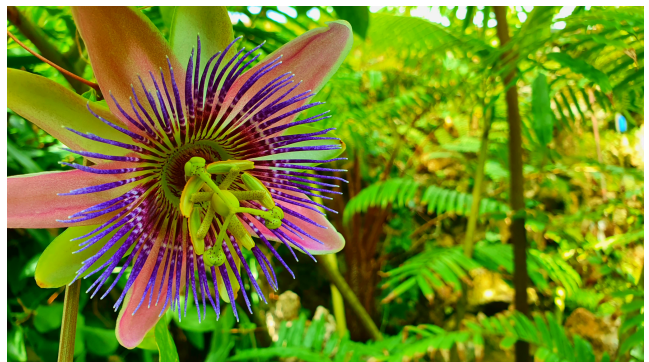


Colin Hepworth
